<u>Application and Re-enrollment Fees</u>		
Application Fee:	\$75	non-refundable, due with each completed <i>Application for Admission</i> form.
Re-enrollment Fee:	\$50	per student, due with completed <i>Re-enrollment</i> form.
Reservation Fee:	\$200	per student, due no later than April 1 or upon acceptance to the school. This will reserve a spot for each child in the family for the grades in which they will be enrolled for 2009-2010. The \$200 will reduce the August tuition for that student by that amount.

Monthly tuition is payable over 11 months (July through May).

Monthly tuition payments are always due on the first of the month, beginning July 1, 2009.

Payments received after the tenth of the month are subject to a \$25 late charge.

For any checks returned to the school by the bank, there will be a \$25 returned check fee.

Accounts two months in arrears may result in the dismissal of the student.

A portion of the cost of the trip to Catalina Island will be assessed directly from each sixth grader's family, in the amount of \$200.00. Some fundraising will still be necessary, but the goal is that this will be completed before the trip. Scholarships/ tuition funds may not be applied to this surcharge.

If a child has been fully enrolled before June 1, 2009 and is withdrawn anytime before the first day of school, August 11, 2009, the parents are liable for payments that were due up to the time of withdrawal (June and/or July). If a child is withdrawn from school by his parents after the school year has begun, the parents will be responsible for tuition through the rest of the semester in which they were enrolled.

If it becomes necessary for parents to withdraw their children during the school year, written notification must be received in advance of the withdrawal date. Fees are non-refundable. Tuition will be due for the semester in which they withdraw. The notification of withdrawal should be received stating reasons for the withdrawal.

Tuition discounts provided by CFCS-CCA for pastors and para-church ministries are as follows:

Pastors (including Assistant Pastors and Youth Pastors) of a church (must be primary bread winner for the family and in a full-time position with the church) are eligible for a 25% tuition discount for their children.

Para-church ministry employees (including, but not limited to missionaries, campus ministers, Christian educators, and others who are working for a Christian 501C3 organization as long as they are the primary breadwinner for the family and in a full-time position with the para-church ministry) are eligible for a 15% tuition discount for their children.

CFCS staff from both campuses who have a child or children enrolled at either campus will be eligible for the following discounts:

Full-time staff will be eligible for a 75% tuition discount for their child or children.

Part-time staff will be eligible for a pro-rated tuition discount of the 75% discount that full-time staff receive.
